Title of the Ex Libris Exhibition: Atatürk and the Republic

Theme of the Ex Libris Exhibition: 100th Anniversary of the Republic, Atatürk, Republic, Freedom, Democracy, Peace

Participants: The exhibition is open to artists, designers, and students from all over the world. Participation at the event is free of charge.

Purpose of the Ex Libris Exhibition: To reveal the importance of such concepts as Republic, Freedom, Peace and Democracy through ex-libris designs, contribute to the promotion of our country, bring together and evaluate original ex-libris artworks, promote and popularise the art of ex-libris as well as creating a permanent collection of artworks for the commemoration of the 100th Anniversary of our Republic and for the museum to be established.

Importance of the Ex LibrisExhibition: It is of much significance to analyse and try to understand the proclamation of the Republic, one of the turning points in Turkish history, its importance, the epic story of the process that Atatürk and his colleagues experienced until the proclamation of the Republic, the importance of the concepts of Freedom and Democracy from a different perspective and express them through the art of ex-libris. These actions and efforts are also significant in terms of explaining it to our youth through art and thus contributing to the visual memory of the 100th Anniversary.

Selection of the Ex Libris Artworks: In the first stage, the participants will send the images of their ex-libris artworks online until **03.09.2023.** The printed version of the ex-libris artworks accepted by the jury must be sent to the specified address via ordinary mail service until **08.10.2023.** Participants whose ex-libris artworks have been accepted will be notified by e-mail and will be announced on the ESOGÜ Faculty of Art and Design web page (https://stf.ogu.edu.tr/).

Phase One: ONLINE SELECTION

Each participant should send his/her application form, profile photo and images of their ex-libris artworks to stfexlibris@gmail.com until 03.09.2023. Participants are required to fill in their information completely. Each participant will send a maximum of 5 photographs of a maximum of 5 artworks, along with their descriptions, biographies/curriculum vitaes and profile photos. Ex Libris images and the participant's profile photo must be in JPG (300 DPI resolution) format in their original colours; ex-libris images should be as close to the original as possible, digital corrections should not be made on the images; the size of the image should not be more than 4 MB. The image must be correctly oriented (vertical or horizontal). Image names should be as follows:

"Country_Surname_Name _Height x Width_Technical" in millimeters. For example: Turkey_Bahar_Tezcan_100x85_CGD

Deadline for the First Application: 03.09.2023

Second Phase: SUBMITTING SELECTED WORKS

The selected ex-libris artworks submitted online should be sent to the address below via mail service until **08.10.2023.** Two signed copies should be sent from each ex-libris. Ex Libris artworks submitted to the exhibition will not be returned. A copy will be placed into the permanent exhibition. The second copy will be included in the museum collection of the Faculty of Art and Design of Eskişehir Osmangazi University. The application form must be sent along with the artworks.

Terms of Application

1. There is no limitation on printing techniques. In addition to the traditional printmaking techniques, photographic works or computer designs shall also be accepted on condition that all works of art should be multi-copied. Photocopies, drawings or sketches shall not be accepted.

2. Artworks should be designed as ex-libris, in other words, they should be designed as a small-sized artworks affixed to books to indicate ownership. The word "Ex Libris" ("Exlibris", "Ex-libris", "Bookplate") or a word with this meaning (from ...'s library) should be placed on the ex-libris together with the name of the owner "living" or the name of the "organization".

3. Participants must sign or initial each ex-libris. On the backside of the ex-libris, the name of the artist, code of the technique, production date, size, and owner's name have to be written in a legible way. Only if the ex-libris owner's initial is used, the full name has to be delivered as well. In case of the usage of a non-Latin alphabet, the Latin alphabet version shall appear on the back of the print with the English translation where necessary.

4. The printing area should not exceed 150×150 mm. Printing paper should not exceed 297×210 mm (A4). Ex Libris shall not be passepartout, glued upon a cardboard or a colored paper. It should be ready for use.

5. Ex Libris must be sent without getting damaged in postal service.

6. The statements "Printed Material" and "No Commercial Value" should be written on the envelope.

7. The digital catalog and participation certificates will be sent to the e-mail addresses of the artists whose artworks are included in the exhibition. The catalog will also be published in PDF format on the ESOGÜ Faculty of Art and Design web page.

8. ESOGÜ Rectorate and the Faculty of Art and Design will be able to use the exhibited ex-libris on their website, CD, catalog, journals or books.
